Our New Sanctuary Piano

Over the past two years, our own Yamaha piano struggled to hold its tuning. A piano like ours usually needs to be tuned one to two times a year, but ours started to need tunings more and more often, to the point where it could barely keep its tuning a week or so after being serviced. We consulted several local, trusted tuners and the diagnosis was not good. Fixing the issue entails replacing both the pins and sound board, as well as the strings. The estimate for such repair work is upwards of \$9,000, an amount we simply do not have.

Upon hearing this, Glenda reached out to her friends Ross and Sylvia Miller who specialize in Yamaha pianos. A family business, Miller Piano Specialists has over 150 years of combined experience in the music industry. Glenda worked with them years ago at a music shop and knew she could trust them for a second opinion. What she heard from them was so much more.

Sylvia grew up in Kingsport and spent her childhood attending Mafair. It was through the ministries at Mafair that she came to know and love Christ and accept Him as her Lord and Savior. When Glenda told her our problem, Sylvia couldn't imagine us not having a properly working, beautifully sounding piano for worship. This prompted her and Ross to donate a new, top of the line, digital Yamaha that will accompany us in worship and song for many years to come.

Our new piano has both the look and feel of a traditional baby grand piano. More than that, it has the sound of a full grand piano! The keys are weighted, and the foot pedals operate just the same as the piano we had. It will integrate into our sound system seamlessly, and has an extensive library of sounds and features.

I know you all join me in celebrating Ross and Sylvia; for their faithfulness, love, and generosity to Mafair and its ministry. Through this gift, I pray our worship and music ministry continues to touch the hearts, lives, and ears of all who worship with us. May we continue to share the love of Christ and be a place he can be experienced by all who enter our doors.
