Upcoming 2nd Floor HVAC Replacement

The HVAC system that serves the second floor of our building has reached the end of its life and will be replaced in its entirety—both the indoor and outdoor units—during this upcoming week.

We are grateful to report that **no additional fundraising or debt will be necessary** for this project. Several years ago, Mafair established an Asset **Replacement Fund**, managed by the Holston Conference Foundation, to prepare for significant infrastructure expenses like this one. Because of the faithful and forward-thinking generosity of our congregation, the fund has sufficient resources to fully cover the cost of the new HVAC system.
